Proof of Jesus' Innocence

- 1) Trial before Anna – no verdict; sent to Caiaphas
- 2) Trial before Caiaphas – no verdict; sent to Pilate
- 3) Evasive indictment – 18:30
- 4) 1st statement: “I find no guilt in him.” – 18:38b
- 5) 2nd statement: “I find no guilt in him.” – 19:4
- 6) 3rd statement: “I find no guilt in him.” – 19:6
- 7) Pilate seeks to release Jesus – 19:12
- 8) Rhetorical Evasion – 19:15

John's “I am” Sayings

A. The First Seven – Who Christ is in relation to salvation

- 1) I am the bread of life -6:35, 41, 48
- 2) I am the light of the world - 8:12; cf. 9:5
- 3) I am the gate for the sheep - 10:7, 9
- 4) I am the good shepherd – 10:11, 14
- 5) I am the resurrection and the life - 11:25
- 6) I am the way and the truth and the life – 14:6
- 7) I am the true vine - 15:1
