

Extra Credit

In addition to extra credit opportunities available on quizzes and exams, a student may comply with the instructions of this assignment in order to receive further credit for increasing one's final grade. The Extra Credit assignment will be due on the last day of class before that day's meeting. The final draft must be submitted on BlackBoard through *Turn-It-In*. No hard copies are required. The grade given for this assignment will replace three of the lowest quiz grades. No late work will be accepted.

The student must read in full one of the books shown on the list below and then write a book review following the instructions in *The Southwestern Seminary Manual of Style* (pg. 123 of the 2007 edition). With regard to organization, the student should attempt to keep the "Summary" section as brief as possible. In addition to the subheading "Critical Evaluation," the student should add another section entitled "Spiritual Development." This part of the review needs to disclose the ways in which the selected book has impacted the student in his or her own personal walk with the Lord, providing specific examples as well as applications. The paper should be 4 to 6 pages (not including "Title Page" or "Bibliography"). If there is not a book on this list that a student has not yet read in totality, then that student may suggest an alternate to read and to review for extra credit upon the professor's approval.
